Primary Care Visits =

Preventative Visits: 99381-99385, 99391-99395 regardless of other CPT codes. Also, 99401-99404 unless associated with an Office Visit code. Included also are immunization codes: 90281-90749.

Office Visit: 99201-99205, 99211-99215 unless associated with Preventative Visit codes.

Team Conference: 99366-99368 unless associated with either Preventative Visit or Office Visit codes.

Behavioral Health Visits = 90785-90911, and H codes. Note: Behavioral Health Visits may overlap with other visits. Data for behavioral health visits may not reflect perfectly actual number of services delivered. If individual and group counseling provided to the same child on the same day by one provider, it will be counted as one visit, not two.

Case Management Visits = T1016, T1017, T2022, T2023.

Dental Visits = Visits with D codes unless associated with Preventative Visit code.

Other = All other encounters that do not fit the above guidelines (e.g., stand-alone lab, radiology, etc.)
